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

.DISCUSSION...

CANADIAN COLD FRONT OVER OREGON WILL BE DROPPING SOUTHWARD ACROSS THE BURN SITE LATE TONIGHT AND TUESDAY. THIS WILL BRING MUCH COLDER TEMPERATURES...LIGHT SPOTTY SHOWERS AND THEN DRY BRISK NORTHERLY WINDS TO THE BURN SITE. THE CORE OF THE STRONGER WINDS IS FORECAST TO REMAIN SOUTH OF THE BURN SITE ON TUESDAY...BUT CONFIDENCE IS LOW TO MEDIUM ON THIS SPECIFIC DETAIL.


